









DAY ONE HONG KONG - PARIS

→ Depart Hong Kong by Air France AF 185 2240 hrs

DAY TWO PARIS- CASABLANCA - RABAT

- → Arrive Paris 0550 am. connect AF 1896 0710 am. Upon arrival Casablanca 1020 am. Met and transfer and driven to city for sightseeing
- → HASSAN II MOSQUE Afternoon guided tour of the third largest mosque in the world. Its minaret has a height of 210 meters (690 ft). Considered as the most ambitious structure ever constructed in Morocco, the Hassan II Mosque rises above the Atlantic Ocean and dominates much of the city's skyline.
- → Stroll to visit THE CORNICHE, continue to visit MOHAMMED V SQUARE, this square, now the municipal administrative centre, consists of many buildings from the 20s, most of them with Hispanic-Muslim architecture and Art Deco influences.
- → Lunch (as dinner will be included at the hotel in Rabat) at RICK'S CAFE, a restaurant, bar and café located in the city of Casablanca. Opened March 1, 2004, the place was designed to recreate the bar made famous by Humphrey Bogart and Ingrid Bergman in the movie classic Casablanca.
- → Travel to **RABAT** (115 min hour drive), the capital of Morocco and a cultural hub of art galleries, museums, and theatres. Overnight Rabat: Hassan deluxe room. Dinner included at the hotel.

DAY THREE RABAT - CHEFCHAOUEN

- → Visit HASSAN TOWER, the MAUSOLEUM OF MOHAMMED V and the ANDALUSIAN GARDENS.
- → **OUDAIAS KASBAH** This 12th century Kabash was built for defensive purposes; beautiful and made up of the Old Town and Medinas of Rabat. It is full of blue and white buildings, shops, and gardens
- → **CHELLAH** A fortified Muslim necropolis with a mosque, minaret and royal tombs dating back to the 14th century.
- → **ROYAL PALACE OF RABAT** Where you can walk the palace grounds and take a photo of the palace from a distance. Take lunch in Rabat and continue to Fes (2 hour drive), for the night.



- → After lunch, embark on your journeys to **CHEFCHAOUEN**, approx. 4 hrs. Explore a hidden gem and one of the most beautiful cities on the planet. It is one of Morocco's best kept secrets. The winding streets are lined with blue-washed buildings. The unusual colour scheme is the reason this city is so striking along with its gorgeous location, nestled into the mountains and surrounded by vegetation.
- → Overnight Chefchaouen: Lina Ryad & Spa dinner included at the hotel.







DAY FOUR CHEFCHAOUEN - FEZ

- → Morning breakfast, recommend you stroll around **Chefchaouen's blue houses** with photo ops on every street corner.
- → Early lunch and embark for exploring **FES** (approx. 3 hrs. 45 min drive) Check in and rest. That evening you will experience a Moroccan night belly dance dinner show.
- → Overnight Fez: Karawan Riad suite Dzhari and Chergui (dinner will be in a local restaurant with Belly dance and show).



DAY FIVE FEZ

- → FEZ A 1,200-year-old city. Visit sites where very little has changed since the city was first established. Explore the labyrinth of narrow streets and main thoroughfares lined with fresh fruit, mounds of spices, intricately woven Berber carpets and many other Moroccan artisanal items.
- → After morning breakfast, enter Fes's medina, home to 400.000 inhabitants, see **Karaouine University, Nejjarine Fountain** and **Dyers Tannery.** The University is the oldest in the world. Explore what was one of the leading spiritual and education centres of the historic Muslim world.
- → Overnight Fez: Karawan Riad suite Dzhari and Chergui dinner included at the Riad.









DAY SIX FEZ - ERFOUD

- → Have a hearty breakfast, going on your journeys to **IFRAN** (70km / 75mins drive), a small town known as "Switzerland of Africa" located in the Middle Atlas Mountains, it has a charming character as the builder adopted a Chalet-style architecture for its houses.
- → After a quick photo stop, take another 2 hours' drive to reach the little town of **MIDELT**, the "City of Apples." Enroute pass through the High Atlas Mountain, If time permits, taste a simple traditional lunch with applie pies for desert drizzled in chocolate and plum sauce
- → We continue to **ERRACHIDIA**, approx. 2 hrs drive. The charming Berber city overlooks the desert. Discover the oasislandscapes at the border of the desert and traditional Arab culture. Your destination will be to **ERFOUS** with another 1-hour drive this "Gate of the Sahara Desert." This charming town rests at the foot of the High Atlas Mountains on the "road of a thousand Kasbahs."
- → Overnight Erfoud: Kasbah Hotel Xaluca Erfoud, dinner included at the hotel.











DAY SEVEN ERFOUD – SAHARA DESERT

- → After checkout, embark on your 4WD Excursion to the Sahara Desert. Explore the **KHAMLIA VILLAGE**, a sanctuary nestled south of Merzouga.
- → You will have chance to experience a Sahara ATV Quad Adventures, with an ATV quad bike tour and dune buggy adventure (Pay on Spot).
- → Depart for a camel ride, wandering around Sahara Desert.
- → Enjoy dinner and an exclusive stargazing experience. Recline under the canopy of stars at your luxury camp and witness constellations, planets and the Milky Way with astonishing clarity and the brilliant Sahara nighttime sky.
- → Overnight Sahara Desert: Tizir Camp with dinner included at the camp



DAY EIGHT SAHARA DESERT – TOUDRA VALLEY - DADES VALLEY





- → Return to camp for breakfast and depart for **TOUDRA VALLEY** (approx. 3.5 hrs.), Visit the Toudra Gorges, a striking natural cliff sided canyon which is renowned for its breathtaking landscapes. Take lunch enroute
- → Continue west in a short journey from Toudra to get to the **DADES VALLEY** where you will stay overnight.











DAY NINE DADES GORGE – QUARZAZATE – AIT BENHADDO

- → Depart for **OUARZAZATE** (approx. 3 hrs.) Pass through the **ROSES VALLEY** where you can see and buy some local rose-products, the road is today called "the road of a thousand kasbahs." Stop to visit Skoura and Amridil Kasbah.
- → Lunch at Ouarzazate, followed by a visit to **ATLAS FILM STUDIOS** (approx. 3 hrs.) which is the world's largest film studio. With a history dating back to the early 1960s, the studios boast an impressive pedigree, having hosted iconic film sets like *Lawrence of Arabia, Gladiator, Star Wars, The Mummy, Jewel of the Nile*, and *Babel*.
- → Later, head to the old village of **AIT BENHADDOU,** a UNESCO Heritage site.
- → Overnight at Ait Benhaddou: Hotel Riad Ksar Ighnda in suite rooms, dinner included at the hotel.

DAY TEN AID BENHADDO - MARRAKECH

- → Morning breakfast check out. You will drive toward to MARRAKECH (approx. 3.5 hours). Enroute visit TELOUET. Drive across the Tizi-n-Tichka Pass, stop along the way for photos and enjoy the panoramic views of the High Atlas Mountains along the berber villages located alongside the road.
- → Evening folklore dinner show & carriage night tour.
- → Overnight at Marrakesh: Villa des Oranges in Intemporelle rooms. Dinner will be at Chez Ali with a Fantasia show.











DAY ELEVEN MARRAKECH

- → Starts your full day sightseeing includes BAHIA PALACE, KOUTOUBIA MINARET, DAR SI SAID MUSEUM, DJEMAA-EL-FNA SQUARE, MENARA GARDENS, MAJORELLE GARDENS.
- → The MAJORELLE GARDENS are one of the most visited sites in Morocco. The famous French painter Jacques Majorelle spent 40 years creating this enchanting place. Walk along the midst of trees, exotic plants, burbling streams and pools filled with lotus flowers. The trained eye will notice a hint of Art Deco here. Visit the Yves Saint Laurent Museum as well.
- → Overnight Marrakech. **Villa des Oranges** in Intemporelle rooms, dinner will be at Dar Dar Rooftop restaurant

DAY TWELVE MARRAKECH - PARIS

→ Morning day free at leisure, around 13:30 hrs you will drive to the airport for flight to Paris by AF 1277 1630 hrs. Connect AF 188 2320 hrs.

DAY THIRTEEN PARIS - HONG KONG

→ Arrive in Hong Kong 18:30 hr.
