

## SEOUL SEARCHING & EXPLORING FANTASTIC SITES IN BUSAN



### DAY ONE HONG KONG - BUSAN

- Depart Hong Kong by UO 674 09:05 , arrive 13:20 hrs. Meet and greet and transfer to hotel check in. Day free at your own leisure.

### DAY TWO BUSAN

- Morning breakfast, your day start to visit Busan city includes of
- **ORYUKDO SKYWALK** An interesting horse-shoe shaped glass bridge which overlooks the ocean. One can take beautiful photos of the amazing cliffs.
- **HAEDONG YONGGUNGSA TEMPLE** A rare find of a temple along the beautiful shoreline as most Korean temples are in the mountains.
- **CHEONGSAPO DARITDOL OBSERVATORY** The 72.5m long and 20m high observatory stretches out impressively over the ocean. You can see the ocean under your feet and enjoy the thrilling experience of walking on the sea.
- **HAEUNDAE BLUELINE PARK** An international tourist city, which was built in an eco-friendly redevelopment of the old railway facility of the East Sea South Line, and operates the Haeundae Beach Train and Haeundae Sky Capsule, which you can ride along the beautiful coastal scenery.



→ **GAMCHEON CULTURE VILLAGE** The village's beautiful landscape gave it the nickname of the Machu Picchu of Korea. In 2009, students, artists, and residents decorated the village as a part of the Village Art Project, and the town grew into a leading tourist attraction of Busan since then.

→ **BUSAN OBSERVATORY** From this excellent vantage, enjoy best views of the ocean, mountain ranges and Busan's famous landmarks.

→ **YONGDUSAN PARK** Yongdusan Park sits on Yongdu Mountain (or Yongdusan), one of the three famous mountains in Busan. Explore Busan Tower, see friendly cats, take snapshots of Korean heritage, Busan skyline at Busan Tower and visit South Korean movie museum.

→ **BIFF SQUARE** The main venue of the Busan International Film Festival. Find handprints of well-known actors and actresses from your favourite K-dramas and films.

→ **GWANGALLI BEACH** Visit in the evening, as at night. It is best known for its magnificent view of Gwangandaegyo Bridge across the ocean and M Drone Light Show.

DAY FOUR BUSAN - SEOUL

→ **HUINNYEOL CULTURE VILLAGE** A charming coastal village named for its meandering stream that resembles the appearance of white snowfall at the foot of Bongnaesan Mountain.

→ **JEORYEONG COASTAL WALK** Scenic walking trails that run parallel to each other along the coastline and clifftop in Yeongdo, Busan.

→ **SONGDO BAY STATION** A thrilling cable car air cruise where you can enjoy being in the middle of the sea, as well as seeing Songdo Beach, Busan Yeongdo and Namhang Bridge, Songdo Coastal Dulle Road, and the surfacing cliffs.

→ **Depart KTX to Seoul approx. 2 hrs. 45 min.**

→ **Private transfer to Hotel. Overnight Seoul.**



## DAY FIVE SEOUL

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- **GYEONGBOK PALACE** The official palace of the Joseon dynasty by Yi Seong-gye, who becomes King Taejo and the founder of the new regime.
- **NATIONAL FOLKLORE MUSEUM** The museum has over 98,000 artifacts and three main exhibition halls.
- **BLUE HOUSE** A public park that formerly served as the presidential residence and the diplomatic reception halls of South Korea from 1948 to 2022.
- **GWANGHWAMUN PLAZA** With 600 years of history, has been reborn as a space for historical and cultural experiences by restoring Yukjo Street.
- **BUKCHON HANOK VILLAGE** Home to hundreds of traditional houses, called hanok, that date back to the Joseon dynasty.
- **INSADONG ANTIQUE STREET** The traditional culture of Korea is represented in the streets of Insadong. During the Joseon Dynasty, the royal studio for painters was here.
- **CHEONGYEcheon STREAM** A 10.9-kilometre-long (6.8 mi) stream and public space, a transformed ecological park of natural beauty after 3 years of restoration project.

## DAY SIX SEOUL

- **DMZ (DEMILITARIZED ZONE)** Nowhere is the tension between North Korea and South Korea more palpable than in the no-man's-land. Only 2.5 miles (4 kilometres) separate the North from the South at what is the most heavily armed border on earth.
- **IMJINGAK PARK** Over 400 photos and documents showing the stark reality of North Korea are displayed in the North Korea Centre of Unification Board.
- **THE 3RD TUNNEL** The 3rd Tunnel is the third of its kind built by North Korea for the purpose of invading South Korea. It was discovered in 1978. Among the four tunnels located so far, it is closest to Seoul.
- **DORA OBSERVATORY** Situated in Paju-si, Gyeonggi-do and at the northernmost point of the Military Demarcation Line.
- **MYEONGDONG SHOPPING DISTRICT and NAMDAEMUN MARKET**
- **N SEOUL TOWER** Built on a 262-meter peak in Namsan Park, the tower reaches to 480 meters above sea level. You can view the entire city and surrounding areas.





→ **NAMI ISLAND** Nami Island is a beautiful destination to visit all year round. Known for appearing in many Korean dramas, the island has numerous lanes lined with pine trees, ginkgo trees, redwood giants and more.

→ **PETITE FRANCE PARK** Designed with the theme concept, "flowers, stars, and the Little Prince," the village offers experience programs, training facilities, and accommodations. Additional attractions within the village include a memorial hall dedicated to Saint-Exupery, the author of the celebrated French novel, Le Petit Prince.

→ **GANGCHON RAIL PARK** After Gyeongchun Subway Line opened, the old train tracks turned into a rail bike park.

→ Return to Seoul and embark on the **HANGANG RIVER CRUISE** The popular Han River (also refer as Hangang) Cruise is operated by E-Land Cruise since 1986. It brings visitors cruising between east and west of Seoul.

→ Overnight Seoul

DAY EIGHT SEOUL

→ **HONGDAE SHOPPING AREA** Hongdae is a popular hang-out for local youths and a must-visit for many foreign tourists to Seoul. A vibrant and busy attraction, popular with shoppers. It has many stalls offering a variety of items to buy and different foods to try.

→ **TRICK EYE MUSEUM & ICE MUSEUM** It turns two-dimensional paintings into three-dimensional images using optical illusions. Paintings on museum walls, floors and ceilings come alive. Visitors are invited to step inside Trick Eye paintings and installations and create their own original stories.

→ **NAMDAEMUN MARKET** This is the city's largest market. Almost everything is available for sale including clothing, souvenirs, purses, and food supplies.

→ On time transfer to Incheon airport for flight UO 627 21:55 hrs, arrives Hong Kong 00:55 am.
